Dear RANDY DOBBINS:

Public Disclosure Commission (PDC) records indicate that you filed as a candidate for public office in 2017 for a jurisdiction with 5,000 or more registered voters. Candidates in these jurisdictions are required to file a Candidate Registration (C-1 report) and a Personal Financial Affairs Statement (F-1 report) within two weeks of declaring their candidacy or no later than June 2, 2017.

As of today, the PDC has not received your C-1 and F-1 reports, and those reports are past due. **To avoid a future enforcement hearing with a possible civil penalty, please file the missing C-1 and F-1 reports with our office by Tuesday, July 25, 2017.** This is the only formal warning notice you will receive from PDC staff regarding this matter. If the missing C-1 and F-1 reports are not received by July 25, staff will likely schedule an enforcement hearing.

PDC CANNOT ACCEPT FAXED, SCANNED, OR EMAILED REPORTS. Blank copies of the C-1 and F-1 reports are enclosed as a courtesy for you to file by mail. Please fill out the forms and mail them back to the PDC immediately. Keep a copy for your campaign records. Additional forms and candidate instructions may be found on our website at www.pdc.wa.gov/learn. Thank you for your prompt attention to this matter.
